Key Skills Covered

In Year 3 and 4 we will be:

- Making predictions of settings, plot and characters using sections from the text and the illustrations.
- Creating character profiles of the main character.
- Developing our understanding of vocabulary .
- Using role play to show understanding of characters emotions.
