#### **Dear Parent/Carer**

This letter explains why we will need to ask for your consent before we are able to take photographs of your child during their time at Ditton CE Junior School.

To comply with the General Data Protection Regulation, we need your permission before we can photograph or make any recordings of your child. If your child is old enough to express their own view, you may want to consult with them about categories of consent, and we invite you to use this letter to explore their feelings about being photographed at the setting.

Please read and complete the attached forms and do not hesitate to contact the School Office should you have any queries.

#### Parental Consent Form for Images

- This form is valid for the period of time your child attends Ditton CE Junior School. The consent will automatically expire after this time. We will not re-use any photographs or recordings after your child leaves the school/setting without additional consent.
- We will not use the personal information or full names (which means first name and surname) of any child
